## SB 1267 (87R) Legislative Report



## **Background Information:**

The Texas Legislature passed Senate Bill 1267 (SB 1267) during the 87th Regular Session, 2021. The legislation required the State Board for Educator Certification (SBEC) to develop and publish a comprehensive clearinghouse of information regarding continuing education and training requirements on seven specific trainings prescribed in the Texas Education Code, by June 1, 2022. Informed by recommendations from the SBEC-approved Clearinghouse Advisory Group (CAG), the SBEC was required to publish a Clearinghouse that includes best practices and industry recommendations for the frequency for training of educators and other school personnel regarding the frequency of each of those seven topics. The legislation also requires the CAG to report any recommended changes on any of the topics to be reduced, eliminated, or consolidated with other existing continuing education or training to the legislature by December 1 of each even-numbered year.

## Required Trainings and Impacts to School Districts and Open-Enrollment **Charter Schools:**
